

Top four Pyrography machines



Ironcore

- Australian Standard
- Made in Victoria
- Interchangeable nibs
- Make your own nibs
- Variable temperature



Razertip

- Made in Canada
 - Australian standard for imports
 - Nibs are locked to the pen.
- Pens can be changed or more expensive interchangeable pen available
- Can get hot where wire joins pen
 - Sometimes fails to burn properly at high temperatures



Burnmaster

- Made in the USA
- Is usually not designed with a pen but will accept any other brand of pen
- More expensive models can support 2 pens



PEM ND-1

- Australian made
- Hand turned pen to custom shape
- Incremental dial preventing very low shading temperatures
